

# ORDINANCE NO. 8079

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 191.04 OF THE CITY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the City has a Job Creation Incentive Program (“J.C.I.P.”) for the stated purpose of attracting new jobs to the City; and,

**WHEREAS**, Council finds that extending the term of the J.C.I.P. grant would promote economic growth and sustain these jobs over a longer period of time without decreasing any additional revenue to the City; and,

**WHEREAS**, Council further finds that this extension furthers the goal of economic development contained in the Defiance Community Strategic Plan;

**Now therefore**, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

**Section 1:** Section 191.04(a) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Defiance, Ohio shall be hereby amended to provide (deleted text ~~stricken~~, newly added text underlined):

**Section 2:** It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session or in Executive Session duly convened in accordance with law.

**Section 3:** This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, safety or welfare of the community for the reason that the City is presented with an immediate economic expansion activity that necessitates this change. As such, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by an affirmative vote of not less than five (5) Members of Council and approval of the Mayor.

# ORDINANCE NO. 8080

## **AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO SUBMIT AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio Development Services Agency (“ODSA”) provides financial assistance to local governments for the purpose of addressing local needs; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Defiance desires to participate in the Program to receive financial assistance to undertake and carry out Community Development activities under the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Economic Development Program Application for the development activities of Cynthia Michaels Salon and Spa, LLC; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Administrator for the City of Defiance may apply for financial assistance and to administer the amounts received from the State of Ohio, Department of Development through its Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Economic Development Program Application for the development activities of Cynthia Michaels Salon and Spa, LLC; and,

**WHEREAS**, Council must direct and authorize the City Administrator to act in connection with the application and to provide such additional information as may be required; and,

**WHEREAS**, Council finds that the administration of CDBG funding in this manner will promote the economic development pillar of the Defiance Community Strategic Plan;

**Now therefore**, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

**Section 1:** The City Administrator is authorized to participate in the State of Ohio, Department of Development Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Economic Development Program Application for the development activities of Cynthia Michaels Salon and Spa, LLC and to provide all information and documentation required in said application for submission.

**Section 2:** The City Administrator is further authorized to file an application for financial assistance under the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Economic Development Program Application for the development activities of Cynthia Michaels Salon and Spa, LLC.

**Section 3:** Council understands and agrees that participation in the program requires compliance with program guidelines and assurances.

**Section 4:** It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session or in Executive Session duly convened in accordance with law.

**Section 5:** This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, safety or welfare of the community for the reason that this Ordinance must be immediately effective to meet required ODSA deadlines. As such, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by an affirmative vote of not less than five (5) Members of Council and approval of the Mayor.
