



ENTRY LEVEL POLICE OFFICER TESTING

The City of Defiance Civil Service Commission is anticipated to conduct testing to establish an eligibility list for the position of Entry Level Police Officer in the Summer or Fall of 2018. Typically, testing has consisted of a written test and physical agility test.

WRITTEN TESTING

Previously, the City has used the National Testing Network website to administer “written” testing for entry level officers. If this method is chosen again, candidates will be able to visit <https://www.nationaltestingnetwork.com/publicsafetyjobs> to review the requirements and details of the Police Officer position, to apply for this position and to schedule a test. National Testing Network Testing centers are located throughout Ohio and allow candidates to choose the date, time, and testing center of their choice.

AGILITY TESTING

After completion of the computerized or written test, and after the testing deadline, the City of Defiance Civil Service Commission will inform candidates if they qualify to take the physical agility test. Usually the agility testing is held at a facility in the City of Defiance. SCORING

Typically, the final eligibility list is established by the City of Defiance Civil Service Commission using a candidates written test score, successful completion of the agility test and Veteran’s Credit if eligible.
