

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR THE 2022 STREET RESURFACING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City identified the necessity for the periodic resurfacing of select streets in 2022; and,

WHEREAS, Ward Construction Co. of Leipsic, OH submitted the lowest and best bid of \$520,977.00 for the project; and,

WHEREAS, Council finds it necessary to maintain City streets and resurface additional streets to provide a reliable transportation network for its residents and businesses;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator is directed to award a contract to Ward Construction Co. to complete the 2022 City Street Resurfacing Project No. 2201 according to the specifications on file with the City Engineer and according to the successful bid dated March 8, 2022 at the total price of \$520,977.00.

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized to pay the contract price from Section 1 from appropriated funds allocated by expenditure from Line 403-901-52-980874 of the 2022 annual budget.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session or in Executive Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, safety, or welfare of the community for the reason that R.C. §153.12(A) requires the award of a contract within sixty days after the date on which the bids are opened or the delay invalidates the entire bid proceedings. As such, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by an affirmative vote of not less than five Members of Council and approval of the Mayor.

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT TO PROVIDE
EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE TO HIGHLAND TOWNSHIP AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City has the capability to provide Advanced Life Support ("ALS") service to Highland Township outside of the municipal boundary; and,

WHEREAS, the Township is willing to compensate the City for coverage by one (1) Emergency Medical Services ("EMS") "Echo" Unit licensed paramedic; and,

WHEREAS, Section 9.60(C), Ohio Revised Code authorizes a governmental entity to contract with another jurisdiction to provide EMS upon approval of the governing boards of each jurisdiction;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator is directed to enter into a contract with the Highland Township Trustees for the provision of EMS service for the remainder of 2022 at the minimum reimbursement rate of \$10,000.00 for the first fifty (50) calls and \$250.00 for each EMS call thereafter.

Section 2: The City Administrator shall execute the Contract for Emergency Medical Services attached hereto as "Exhibit A" or in substantially similar form absent a material change.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session or in Executive Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, safety, or welfare of the community for the reason that Council desires the contract to take effect on April 1, 2022. As such, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by an affirmative vote of not less than five (5) Members of Council and approval of the Mayor.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT SQUAD AMBULANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City intends to replace a 2003 model ambulance with a 2022 Ford F-550 diesel four-by-four chassis vehicle; and,

WHEREAS, Council authorized the purchase of a squad ambulance in Ordinance No. 8377 on January 25, 2022, but that vendor was unable to provide the vehicle at the quoted price; and,

WHEREAS, the City has found a new quote from the State Term Schedule ("STS") from Horton Emergency Vehicles that adheres to this schedule in the amount of \$259,305.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Administrative Services procured the item at a competitive rate through the Cooperative Purchasing Program;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator is authorized to contract for the assembly of one Horton 603F-1 on a 2022 Ford F-550 containing a diesel chassis, and all accessory equipment specified by the Horton Emergency Vehicles quotation on file with the Fire Chief through the Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program (State Term Schedule 233) and at the quoted price of \$259,305.00.

Section 2: Payments for the squad vehicle are not due until 2023. The Finance Director is thereby authorized to pay the contract price from funds allocated for the replacement of Squad 212 from 2023 annual budget for capital improvements.

Section 3: Upon delivery and acceptance of the replacement ambulance, the City Administrator is authorized to sell Squad 212 as municipal surplus in accordance with Codified Ordinance 151.04(b).

Section 4: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session or in Executive Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 5: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, safety, or welfare of the community for the reason that Council desires to avoid any further surprise price increases that would have an adverse impact on the provision of cost-effective emergency services. As such, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by an affirmative vote of not less than five (5) Members of Council and approval of the Mayor.
