**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING RENEWAL OF A CONTRACT WITH
DEFIANCE COUNTY FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES
INCURRED TO PROVIDE LEGAL SERVICES TO INDIGENT
DEFENDANTS PROSECUTED IN MUNICIPAL COURT UNDER
MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, the State Public Defender allocates funds to Defiance County for payment of expenses incurred to provide legal services to indigent persons charged with offenses punishable by incarceration; and,

WHEREAS, an October 15, 2012 agreement between the City and County has enabled the County to allocate a portion of the funds received from the State Public Defender to pay expenses incurred to provide constitutionally-required legal services to persons prosecuted for offenses proscribed by municipal ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, this agreement can be renewed annually by Ordinance of Council and Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, on October 14, 2021, the Board of Commissioners of Defiance County, Ohio adopted a Resolution authorizing renewal of the agreement for calendar year 2022;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The agreement between the City of Defiance and County of Defiance entitled, "Agreement for Indigent Defense Services in Municipal Court (Assigned Counsel)" is hereby extended without modification for the period beginning January 1, 2022, and ending December 31, 2022.

Section 2: The City Finance Director is authorized to receive and disburse funds in accordance with the agreement during calendar year 2022.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session or in Executive Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be effective on the earliest date permitted by law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 139.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF DEFIANCE, OHIO

WHEREAS, Council last set the composition of the Police Division in Ordinance No. 6153 on September 5, 2000; and,

WHEREAS, Council finds that the needs of this Division have changed, in particular the necessity of adding a School Resource Officer ("SRO") at the level of patrolman to the roster; and,

WHEREAS, the City has eliminated all of the dispatcher positions and now shares those services with the Defiance County 911 Center;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: Section 139.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Defiance, Ohio is hereby amended to provide (deleted text stricken, newly added text underlined):

139.01 COMPOSITION.

In addition to the City Administrator, the Chief of Police and such emergency patrolmen as may be appointed by the Mayor, the Police Division shall be composed of the following officers and other members:

- (a) An Assistant Chief of Police;
- (b) Four lieutenants;
- (c) Four sergeants-technicians;
- (d) ~~Twenty-one~~ Twenty-two patrolmen; and
- (e) ~~Seven clerk-dispatchers.~~

Section 2: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session or in Executive Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be effective on the earliest date permitted by law and shall apply to new and existing drop-off boxes, alike.

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DEFIANCE COUNTY BUDGET
COMMISSION'S ALTERNATE PLAN OF APPORTIONMENT
OF THE UNDIVIDED LOCAL GOVERNMENT FUNDS.**

WHEREAS, the Defiance County Budget Commission has proposed an alternate plan of apportionment of the undivided local government funds, and

WHEREAS, an alternate plan requires the consent of each affected local governmental entity in order to be adopted and implemented,

Now, therefore, be it Resolved by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Defiance County, Ohio, that:

Section 1: Any hearings before the Defiance County Budget Commission regarding apportionment of the undivided local government fund pursuant to Section 5747, Ohio Revised Code are hereby waived. This Council agrees to the Defiance County Budget Commission alternate plan of apportionment of the local government funds on the basis of need and the amount received in past years and agrees to accept the sum of One-hundred eighty-eight-thousand seven-hundred-forty-four and 90/100 dollars (\$188,744.90) as its 15.8% share of the undivided local government fund.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
