AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF MOBILE VIDEO RECORDING SYSTEMS FOR THE POLICE DIVISION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Police Division uses mobile video recording systems ("MVRs") to assist officers in performing their duties and capture video of cases and interactions with the public; and,

WHEREAS, the current MVRs are aging and in need of replacement; and,

WHEREAS, the Police Division received a quote for eleven (11) Focus H1 MVRs containing computer equipment, software, hardware, licensing, support, and maintenance agreements from Safe Fleet for a total amount of \$66,526.00; and,

WHEREAS, Council finds that the City met the competitive bidding requirements for these items contained in §151.03(a) of the Codified Ordinances by locating and selecting them through an Ohio Department of Administrative Services State Term Schedule Participant and therefore complies with such requirements pursuant to §131.02(e) of the Codified Ordinances;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator, as Director of the Department of Service and Safety, is directed to enter into a contract with Safe Fleet for eleven (11) Focus H1 MVRs containing computer equipment, software, hardware, licensing, support, and maintenance agreements according to the specifications on file with the Chief of Police and at the quoted price of \$66,526.00.

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized to pay the total cost of this equipment quoted in Section 1 from Line 201-301-52-935008 of the 2022 annual budget.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session or in Executive Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, safety, or welfare of the community for the reason that maintaining up-to-date systems in law enforcement vehicles enhances the police protection of the City. As such, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by an affirmative vote of not less than five (5) Members of Council and approval of the Mayor.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF BODY WORN CAMERAS FOR THE POLICE DIVISION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Ohio Attorney General ("OAG") awarded a grant to the City for the acquisition and implementation of body worn cameras for the Police Division; and,

WHEREAS, the Police Division received a quote for fourteen (14) Focus X2 Body Worn Cameras, vehicle equipment, computer software, hardware, licensing, support, and maintenance agreements from Safe Fleet for a total amount of \$74,270.00; and,

WHEREAS, the grant award will cover \$73,663.00 of this initial cost; and,

WHEREAS, Council finds that the City met the competitive bidding requirements for these items contained in §151.03(a) of the Codified Ordinances by locating and selecting them through an Ohio Department of Administrative Services State Term Schedule Participant and therefore complies with such requirements pursuant to §131.02(e) of the Codified Ordinances;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator, as Director of the Department of Service and Safety, is directed to enter into a contract with Safe Fleet for fourteen (14) Focus X2 Body Worn Cameras, vehicle equipment, computer software, hardware, licensing, support, and maintenance agreements according to the specifications on file with the Chief of Police and at the quoted price of \$74,270.00.

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized to pay the total cost of this equipment quoted in Section 1 from Line 201-301-52-923011 of the 2022 annual budget.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session or in Executive Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, safety, or welfare of the community for the reason that immediate placement of this order is necessary to comply with the OAG grant timeline. As such, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by an affirmative vote of not less than five (5) Members of Council and approval of the Mayor.

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR THE WATERLINE REPLACEMENT AND RESURFACING OF WEST HIGH STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the existing waterline adjacent to West High Street from Clinton Street to Harding Street requires total replacement; and,

WHEREAS, the City intends to resurface West High Street from the Clinton Street intersection to the western municipal boundary; and,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer solicited competitive bids and Hillabrand & Sons Construction, LLC of Northwood, OH submitted the lowest and best bid of \$1,339,620.15 for the project; and,

WHEREAS, Council finds it necessary to maintain its network of City streets and utilities in order to provide reliable service networks for its residents and businesses;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator is directed to award a contract to Hillabrand & Sons Construction, LLC to complete the West High Street Waterline Replacement and Pavement Resurfacing Project No. 1914 according to the specifications on file with the City Engineer and according to the successful, and sole, bid dated April 5, 2022 at the total price of \$1,339,620.15.

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized to pay the contract price from Section 1 from appropriated funds allocated by expenditure from the following line items of the 2022 annual budget:

- Line 403-901-52-979102: \$678,557.81; and
- Line 591-538-52-980880: \$661,062.34.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session or in Executive Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, safety, or welfare of the community for the reason that R.C. §153.12(A) requires the award of a contract within sixty days after the date on which the bids are opened or the delay invalidates the entire bid proceedings. As such, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by an affirmative vote of not less than five (5) Members of Council and approval of the Mayor.
