AN ORDINANCE AWARDDING A CONTRACT FOR THE DESIGN, IMPLEMENTATION, AND HOSTING OF A NEW CITY WEBSITE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City has maintained the same website for several years and has identified the necessity of migrating to a new website with enhanced functionality; and,

WHEREAS, City staff solicited quotes from multiple web hosting vendors and identified CivicPlus of Manhattan, KS as the firm with the most capability of aiding the City in this endeavor; and,

WHEREAS, CivicPlus submitted a quote for the design, implementation, hosting, and support of the website at a cost of \$34,293.00 for the first year and \$9,817.50 for the second year; and,

WHEREAS, Council finds that the engagement with this firm will aid the municipal government in communication, transparency, and outreach to City residents;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator is directed to enter the Statement of Work Agreement on file in the office of the Law Director according to the quotes received on June 28, 2022 and July 8, 2022, respectively for the total amounts of \$34,293.00 for the first year and \$9,817.50 for the second year.

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized to pay the contract price from Section 1 from appropriated funds allocated by expenditure from Line 101-172-52-974045 of the 2022 annual budget.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session or in Executive Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, safety, or welfare of the community for the reason that these quotes have expiration dates and prices are apt to increase. As such, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by an affirmative vote of not less than five (5) Members of Council and approval of the Mayor.

AN ORDINANCE AWARDED A CONTRACT FOR PAVEMENT MARKING THROUGHOUT THE CITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City Engineer advertised for bids to supply labor, equipment, fuel, and materials to refresh center lines, edge lines, lane lines, and channel lines on public streets throughout the city in accordance with plans and material specifications on file as Engineering Division Project No. 2202; and,

WHEREAS, Griffin Pavement Striping, LLC of Fremont, Ohio submitted the lowest and best bid in the amount of \$55,642.00; and,

WHEREAS, Council finds that annual pavement marking supports the Connectivity Pillar of the Defiance Community Strategic Plan by providing a safe and reliable transportation network for City residents;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator is directed to award a contract to Griffin Pavement Striping, LLC in the amount of \$55,642.00 to apply pavement markings conforming to the plans and specifications established by the lowest and best bid at the prices and on the terms and conditions of performance of the accepted bid.

Section 2: The Finance Director is directed to pay costs of the contract authorized by Section 1 from Line 202-901-52-980882 of the 2022 annual budget.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session or in Executive Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, safety, or welfare of the community for the reason that R.C. §153.12(A) requires the award of a contract within sixty days after the date on which the bids are opened or the delay invalidates the entire bid proceedings. As such, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by an affirmative vote of not less than five (5) Members of Council and approval of the Mayor.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF TWO VALVE INSERTIONS FOR THE MAUMEE RIVER WATERLINE CROSSING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City identified the need to replace a sixteen-inch waterline that crosses the Maumee River from the approximate area of Biede Avenue to the intersection of Carpenter Road and E. River Drive; and,

WHEREAS, the City Water Distribution Division further identified the need to install two 16" valve insertions on either side of the Maumee River in order to reduce disruption of water service during construction of this new waterline crossing; and,

WHEREAS, Hydra-Stop of Burr Ridge, IL submitted the lowest quote for the equipment for a total of \$42,216.00;

Now therefore, be it enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Defiance, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Administrator is directed to award a contract to Hydra-Stop in the amount of \$42,216.00 for the delivery of two 16" valve insertions and cartridges for the planned waterline crossing conforming to the plans and specifications established by the quote on file in the office of the Water Distribution Superintendent.

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized to pay the costs of the equipment authorized by Section 1 from Line 591-538-52-980880 of the 2022 annual budget.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all legislative actions pertaining to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in Public Session and that all deliberations that affected or influenced any such legislative act, including all deliberations in Committee, were conducted in Public Session or in Executive Session duly convened in accordance with law.

Section 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, safety, or welfare of the community for the reason that the lead time to obtain this equipment through the supply chain is three-to-four months. Time is of the essence to complete this waterline crossing project and maintain adequate water service to properties on the north side of the Maumee River. As such, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by an affirmative vote of not less than five (5) Members of Council and approval of the Mayor.
